The Business Council of Papua New Guinea, in association with the Australia Papua New Guinea Business Council, is pleased to announce the 27th Papua New Guinea Australia Business Forum and Trade Expo will be held in Madang, Papua New Guinea, from Sunday 15th to Tuesday 17th May 2011. The Forum is the major annual bilateral business meeting between Papua New Guinea and Australia. Participants will have an unparalleled opportunity to learn about business opportunities in Papua New Guinea, and to network with senior Australia and Papua New Guinea based policy makers and senior business people.

The program for the Forum includes an overview of the political and economic climate, especially issues which affect business and investment, and will include specific sessions by expert presenters on doing business in Papua New Guinea. Topics will include agriculture, business opportunities in the mining/resources sector, health, education, infrastructure, opportunities for business partnerships with government, and how business can work effectively with Government to address capacity challenges to meet the needs of Papua New Guinea. Key government ministers from Papua New Guinea and Australia have been invited to address the Forum to inform business representatives of policy issues in their portfolio relevant to business.

Outcomes expected from the meeting will be improved understanding by businesses in Papua New Guinea and Australia of the opportunity for further developing the bilateral business and investment relationship. This will include receiving information about opportunities for business in new resource projects in Papua New Guinea. A further outcome will be the identification for governments of issues which business groups in each country regard as requiring government policy or administrative action to facilitate bilateral business and investment growth.
